2011 Cascade Scale Rally Report

May 20 – 23, 2011 the Cascade Scale Rally was hosted by the Washington Scale Squadron at the Cascade Family Flyer's field near Snohomish. We had 22 registered entries from 17 pilots with good participation from out of town, roughly 50% were from out of State – Oregon, Idaho and British Columbia.

The event was low key and fun; we enjoyed good flying weather. The event was a Scale Masters Qualifier – Entry Classes were Fun Scale, Open, Advanced, Team and Expert. The categories allow beginners with Almost Ready to Fly Airplanes to participate along with experienced flyers and builders. An ideal venue for learning to improve one's flying and building skills.

Static was on Friday and pilots had a chance for some practise flying.

Two flight lines with 3 rounds flown on Saturday - Sunday was" rain delayed" by 1 hour which resulted in one more round of flying - there were no downed aircraft during the event.

Pilots may use their Cascade Scale Rally score for entry into the September North West Scale Championships in Boise, Idaho.

The North West Scale Championships in Boise, Idaho is also a "US Scale Masters Qualifier" (Two Events held together).

- The North West Championships event; will combine the score you bring from "one"
 other recognized AMA or MAAC judged competition with all the flight scores and the
 static score received at the US SM Qualifier portion of the event.
- Scale classes for the NW Championships and the US SM Qualifier are;
 - Fun Scale, Open, Advanced, Team and Expert.

The event will be fun, hope to see you there.
