

Contest Menu

NOTE: NWSAM Recognizes that there are a wide variety of agreement types between clubs for the hosting of Scale Contests. From a Home club that does it all; takes all of the risk and therefore reaps all rewards, to a Home club that rents NWSAM the field; taking no risk and only the agreed rent as a reward.

This document is a starting place for revenue sharing negotiations for situations that fall somewhere in between those two extremes. Agreement should be reached prior to the event.

It is the assumption that reaching an agreement with NWSAM results in an entry fee reduction for current NWSAM members.

(An agreement between NorthWest Scale Aero-Modellers *hereafter NWSAM* and _____ *hereafter 'home club'*)

<u>Line item & definition</u>	<u>Percentage of proceeds</u>
Venue- <i>provision of site, set-up, clean up, trash haul-out</i>	30% of Registration
CD- <i>event management, sanction, flyers, trophies, advertising Water for judges, AMA paperwork completion</i>	25% of Registration
Scorekeeping- <i>laptop, printer, paper, ink, registration, scoring Posting, scoreboard, clipboards, pens</i>	30% of Registration
Judges- <i>providing static and/or flight judges. A sliding scale- Based on percentage of judges from home club not to exceed a Total of 15 % registration revenue</i>	15% of Registration

On-Site Food (optional- but nice)- *lunches Sat & Sun, possible Dinner Sat night. Can be provided by home club or vendor as Arranged by home club.*

100% of food proceeds
to whomever provides it

Camping (at discretion of home club)

100% of camping proceeds
to home club

Raffle (at discretion of home club)
Appropriation of prizes, ticket sales, drawing

100% of raffle proceeds
to whomever organizes and
provides raffle prizes

The purpose of this agreement is to encourage home clubs towards incremental ownership of NWSAM Eligibility events. As Home Clubs take more and more responsibility of critical contest tasks and infrastructure, the Home Club takes more of the contest proceeds.
